Fajarbaru-Beulah Melbourne project completed

PETALING JAYA: Fajarbaru Builder Group Bhd and its Australian partner Beulah International have completed their A\$77mil (RM260mil) residential development in Melbourne.

All 136 apartments at the Gardenhill project were almost sold out, the companies said in a joint statement yesterday.

“Gardenhill’s innovative design and expansive list of amenities, such as Australia’s first Dog Park and the innovative interior sliding panels, have proved to be widely popular with both local owner occupiers and downsizers who view good design as an essential part of modern living,” said Fajarbaru-Beulah executive director Chan Jiaheng.

Melbourne-based Beulah has since purchased four more sites around Melbourne for future development, including the iconic and widely publicised Celtic Club in Melbourne’s central business district.

The iconic mixed-use 48-level tower in the heart of Melbourne will comprise about 220 plus luxury apartments and will be launched in Malaysia by end of April.
